1. Eligibility Criteria for Position in the faculty of Arts, Science, Commerce, Law and Agriculture.

(Minimum eligibility and qualification shall be as per UGC (Minimum Qualifications for Appointment of Teachers and other Academic Staff in Universities and Colleges and other Measures for the Maintenance of Standards in Higher Education) Regulations, 2018)

I. Assistant Professor:

Eligibility (A or B):

A.

- i) A Master's degree with 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point-scale wherever the grading system is followed) in a concerned/relevant/allied subject from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign university.
- Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC or the CSIR, or a similar test accredited by the UGC, like SLET/SET or who are or have been awarded a Ph. D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of M.Phil./Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009 or 2016 and their amendments from time to time as the case may be exempted from NET/SLET/SET:

Provided, the candidates registered for the Ph.D. programme prior to July 11, 2009, shall be governed by the provisions of the then existing Ordinances/Bye-laws/Regulations of the Institution awarding the degree and such Ph.D. candidates shall be exempted from the requirement of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/Colleges/Institutions subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions:-

- a) The Ph.D. degree of the candidate has been awarded in a regular mode;
- b) The Ph.D. thesis has been evaluated by at least two external examiners;
- c) An open Ph.D. viva voce of the candidate has been conducted;
- d) The Candidate has published two research papers from his/her Ph.D. work, out of which at least one is in a refereed journal;
- e) The candidate has presented at least two papers based on his/her Ph.D work in

conferences/seminars sponsored/funded/supported by the UGC / ICSSR/ CSIR or any similar agency.

The fulfilment of these conditions is to be certified by the Registrar or the Dean (Academic Affairs) of the University concerned.

Note: NET/SLET/SET shall also not be required for such Masters Programmes in disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET is not conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC, like SLET/SET.

OR

B. The Ph.D. degree has been obtained from a foreign university/institution with a ranking among top 500 in the World University Ranking (at any time) by any one of the following: (i) Quacquarelli Symonds (QS) (ii) the Times Higher Education (THE) or (iii) the Academic Ranking of World Universities (ARWU) of the Shanghai Jiao Tong University (Shanghai).

Note: The Academic score as specified in Appendix II (Table 3A) for Universities, and Appendix II (Table 3B) for Colleges, shall be considered for short-listing of the candidates for interview only, and the selections shall be based only on the performance in the interview.

II. Associate Professor:

Eligibility:

- i) A good academic record, with a Ph.D. Degree in the concerned/allied/relevant disciplines.
- ii) A Master's Degree with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point-scale, wherever the grading system is followed).
- iii) A minimum of eight years of experience of teaching and / or research in an academic/research position equivalent to that of Assistant Professor in a University, College or Accredited Research Institution/industry with a minimum of seven publications in the peer-reviewed or UGC-listed journals and a total research score of Seventy five (75) as per the criteria given in Appendix II, Table 2.

III. Professor: Eligibility

A.

- i) An eminent scholar having a Ph.D. degree in the concerned/allied/relevant discipline, and published work of high quality, actively engaged in research with evidence of published work with, a minimum of 10 research publications in the peer-reviewed or UGC-listed journals and a total research score of 120 as per the criteria given in Appendix II, Table 2.
- ii) A minimum of ten years of teaching experience in university/college as Assistant Professor/Associate Professor/Professor, and / or research experience at equivalent level at the University/National Level Institutions with evidence of having successfully guided doctoral candidate.

OR

B. An outstanding professional, having a Ph.D. degree in the relevant/allied/applied disciplines, from any academic institutions (not included in A above) / industry, who has made significant contribution to the knowledge in the concerned/allied/relevant discipline, supported by documentary evidence provided he/she has ten years' experience.

- 1. Applicants must fulfill the minimum essential qualifications of the post and other desirable qualifications as stipulated in the advertisement.
- 2. The qualifications, Pay Scales and other conditions for the teaching positions shall be in accordance with the UGC Regulations on Minimum Qualifications for Appointment of Teachers and other Academic Staff in Universities and Colleges and Measures for the Maintenance of Standards in Higher Education 2018 (herein after referred to as UGC Regulations, 2018).
- 3. As per UGC Regulations, 2018, the norms or standards laid down by different regulatory bodies e.g. PCI etc. in relevant disciplines shall be applicable.
- 4. Mere eligibility will not entitle any candidate to be called for an interview. The short listing of the candidates to be called for interview shall be done as per Appendix II Table: 3A of UGC Regulations, 2018 subject to fulfilling all the essential eligibility criteria as mentioned for Direct Recruitment for the post of Assistant Professor in the UGC Regulations, 2018.
- 5. Scrutiny and short listing of the applications will be done as per Governor Secretariate, Uttar Pradesh, Lucknow order No. 3019/32-GS/2020 dated. 18-05-2021, Order No. E-4229/G.S. Dated 02-07-2021 and Order No. E-3047/G.S. Dated 22-05-2022.
- 6. Only matriculation/SSC certificate/pass certificate issued by the concerned educational board will be considered as proof for date of birth. No other document will be accepted for verification of date of birth.

- 7. Advertisement. No., Post code and the post applied for should be clearly indicated in the online application form.
- 8. Incomplete applications or applications not in prescribed proforma shall not be entertained.
- 9. The University reserves the right:
 - (a) To increase/decrease the number of positions at the time of interview/selection.
 - (b) To fix criteria for short-listing the applications/applicants.
 - (c) To withdraw the advertisement either partly or fully at any time without assigning any reason.
 - (d) To fill or not to fill up some or all the positions advertised without assigning any reason.
 - (e) To alter/insert any corrections/additions in the advertisement on the website, if required, before the last date of the online application.
 - (f) In case of any inadvertent mistake in the process of selection, which may be detected at any stage even after the issue of appointment letter, the University reserves the right to cancel the appointment and communicate the same to the candidate.
- 10. An application fee of Rs. 1500/- for Unreserved/OBC applicants and Rs.1000 for SC/ST/EWS/PWD for each teaching post applied for is to be paid online with the application.
- 11. Separate applications along with separate application fee should be submitted for each position applied for.
- 12. A relaxation of 5% shall be allowed at the Bachelor's as well as at the Master's level for the candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe/Other Backward Classes (OBC)(Non-creamy Layer)/Differently- abled ((a) Blindness and low vision; (b) Deaf and Hard of Hearing; (c) Locomotor disability including cerebral palsy, leprosy cured, dwarfism, acidattack victims and muscular dystrophy; (d) Autism, intellectual disability, specific learning disability and mental illness; (e) Multiple disabilities from amongst persons under (a) to (d) including deaf-blindness) for the purpose of eligibility and assessing good academic record for direct recruitment. The eligibility marks of 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever the grading system is followed) and the relaxation of 5% to the categories mentioned above are permissible, based only on the qualifying marks without including any grace mark procedure.
- 13. A relaxation of 5% shall be provided, (from 55% to 50% of the marks) to the Ph.D. Degree holders who have obtained their Master's Degree prior to 19 September, 1991.
- 14. A person suffering from disability up to 40% or more shall be eligible for the benefit of the reservation for PWD category.
- 15. Candidates belonging to SC/ST/OBC category should submit proper caste certificate as per the proforma of Govt. of Uttar Pradesh. The certificate shall not be more than 06 months old in case of SC/ST/OBC/EWS.
- 16. Candidates belonging to the OBC category but coming in creamy layer will not be entitled to the benefit of reservation and shall have to apply as Unreserved candidate.
- 17. Candidates belonging to EWS should submit proper certificate as per the proforma of Uttar Pradesh Government.
- 18. Candidates applying for the post of Professor and Associate Professor are advised to satisfy themselves before applying that they possess the minimum API Score, as per UGC Regulations 2018.
- 19. If a candidate wishes to be considered in his/her own category and Unreserved category as well, he/she will have to mark it in his/her form at the prescribed place.
- 20. Candidates must be in sound health. They must, if selected will have to undergo such medical examination and satisfy competent medical authority as the University may require.
- 21. The candidates employed of Govt./Private Universities/Colleges/Autonomous bodies should apply with the recent copy of the NOC, Salary Slip & ITR etc. They must produce the NO OBJECTION CERTIFICATE (NOC) from their organization at the time of interview with a certificate that (i) no vigilance case is pending/being contemplated against him/her (ii) the applicant will be relieved within one month of receipt of appointment offer, if he/she is selected. Concealment of fact, supply of false documents, providing false or misleading information or canvassing in any manner shall amount to the disqualification.
- 22. No T.A./D.A. will be paid to the candidates for appearing before the interview.
- 23. The candidates selected shall be appointed on probation for a period of one year which can be extended for another one year as per decision of the Executive Council, on the ground of unsatisfactory performance, misconduct or misbehavior.
- 24. For further correspondence, interview letters etc. candidates must check their Emails regularly. Email will be provided for the purpose.

- 25. Candidates are expected to visit the University official website www.prsuniv.ac.in regularly for the latest information.
- 26. Submitted online application can be downloaded and the same should be reach to The Registrar, Prof. Rajendra Singh (Rajju Bhaiya) University, Prayagraj-211010, U.P. before 20th of May, 2025 along with self-attested copies of the academic marksheet, certificate, experience certificate, cast certificate, EWS certificate NOC and publications. The original certificates will be required at the time of interview.
- 27. The University reserves the right to Revise/Reschedule/Cancel/Suspend the recruitment process without assigning any reason. The decision of the University shall be final and no appeal in this regard shall be entertained.
- 28. Candidates must ensure before applying that they are eligible according to the criteria stipulated in the advertisement. If the candidate is found ineligible at any stage of the recruitment process, he/she will be disqualified. No refund of fees will be made. Concealment of fact/information or submitting false information will lead to cancellation of candidature at any stage of recruitment. In case of hiding any information, the candidature will be cancelled. Even if the selection has been made the appointment will be terminated and departmental proceedings shall be initiated.

- b) For the post of Assistant Professor, the selection process shall be conducted in two parts: (i) short-listing and (ii) interview
- c) For the post of Assistant Professor, the 'Basic Academic Score and API Score' shall be calculated as per the as per UGC-Regulations 2018, Appendix II, Table 3A.
- d) For the post of Assistant Professor, there shall be a written objective examination of the relevant discipline/ branch of 40 Marks.

- h) For the post of Assistant Professor, a 'Consolidated Merit List' shall be prepared based on the combined score of 'Basic Academic Score and API Score' and 'written test'. From this merit list appropriate number of candidates shall be shortlisted for 'Interview' which will be conducted in two parts: (i) Assessment of teaching skills and (ii) Interview.
- i) For the post of Associate Professor and Professor, the selection process shall be conducted in two parts: (i) short-listing and (ii) interview
- j) For the post of Associate Professor and Professor, the 'Basic Academic Score and API Score' shall be calculated as per the as per UGC-Regulations 2018, Appendix II, Table 2.
- k) For the post of Associate Professor and Professor, a 'Consolidated Merit List' shall be prepared based on the combined score of 'Basic Academic Score and API.
- For the post of Associate Professor and Professor, the candidates shall be given a time of at least seven days from the date of publication of cumulative score of Basic Academic Score and API I Research Score, for inviting objections.
- m) A duly constituted "Selection Committee" will conduct the interview process and shall submit the final result in sealed envelope to the Vice Chancellor.

Assessment must be based on evidence produced by the teacher such as: copy of publications, project sanction letter, utilization and completion certificates issued by the University and acknowledgements for patent filing and approval letters, students' Ph.D. award letter, etc.

- (a) Two authors: 70% of total value of publication for each author.

Joint Projects: Principal Investigator and Co-investigator would get 50% each.

- Paper presented if part of edited book or proceeding then it can be claimed only once.
- For joint supervision of research students, the formula shall be 70% of the total score for Supervisor and Co-supervisor. Supervisor and Co-supervisor, both shall get 7 marks each.
- *For the purpose of calculating research score of the teacher, the combined research score from the categories of 5(b). Policy Document and 6. Invited lectures/Resource Person/Paper presentation shall have an upper capping of thirty percent of the total research score of the teacher concerned.

- The API/Research score secured -by candidates as per Table 4 shall be scaled down to a maximum of 50.
